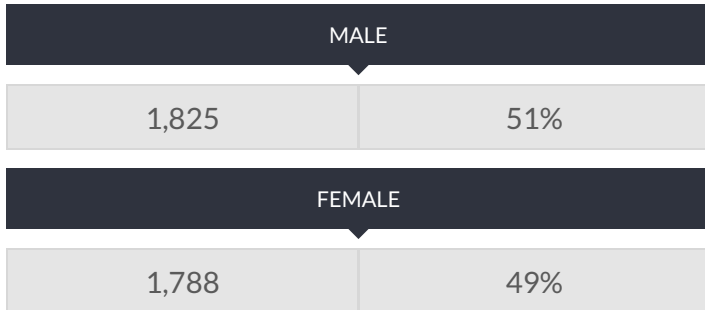

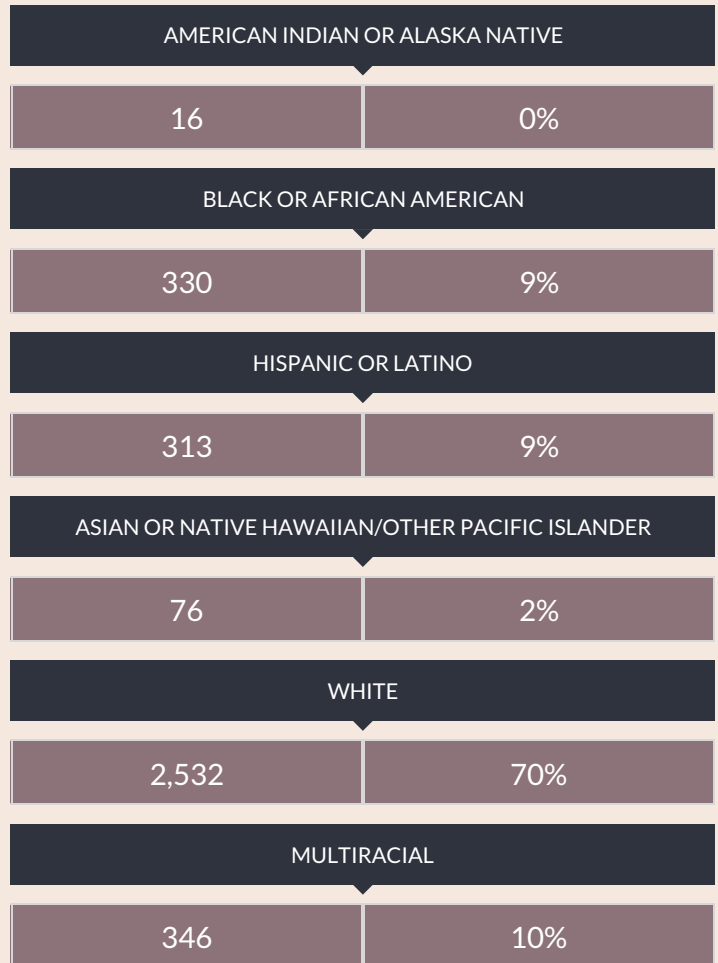
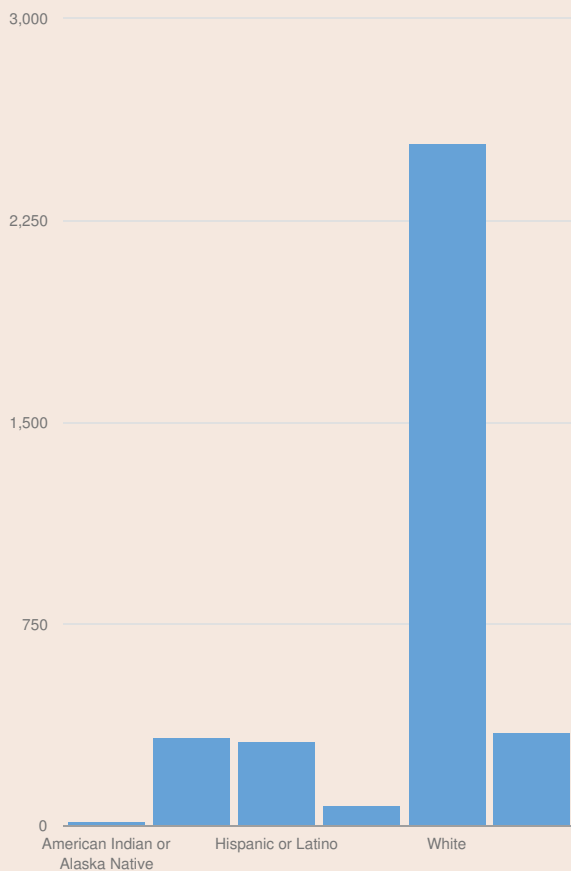
## UNION-ENDICOTT CSD ENROLLMENT (2017 - 18)

### ENROLLMENT BY GENDER



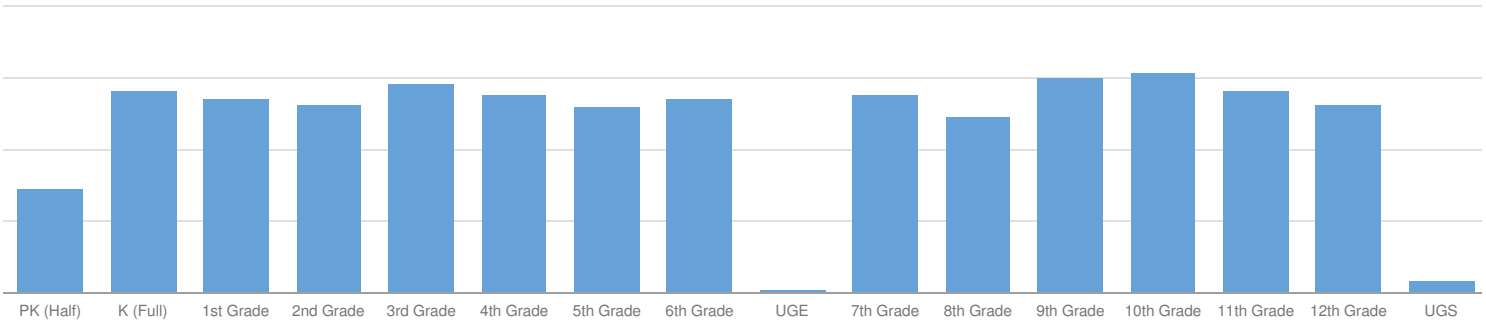
### ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY
